

GLASTONBURY FESTIVAL 2009

Is paid work available?

Yes. Working for CTM you will not only receive your festival ticket you will also get paid an hourly rate of £6.21 and be provided with a basic packed lunch. You will be paid for Glastonbury on the 15th July either directly into your bank account or by cheque.

What is the Job?

CTM run the car parks and Glastonbury. You will either be parking cars, checking tickets or directing traffic during your shifts.

Is there an age limit?

Yes there is a minimum age of 18

When are the shifts?

Work is available 21st June - 29th June. All employees must be available to work at least from Wednesday 24th to Monday 29th June.

What are the shifts?

Day and night shifts are available and are allocated on a first come first served basis. Shifts may be filled before the closing date.

Between Weds 24th - Monday 29th June shifts are 12hrs

Between Sunday 21st - 23rd (limited availability) shifts are 8hrs:- you will have to do these in addition to 12hr shifts.

Will I be able to change my shifts?

Only if an alternative shift is still available and you contact the Coventry office directly before 20th May. Once onsite you will not be able to change your shifts

Deposits

As in previous years, CTM are operating a deposit system.

The deposit amount for applications before 1st Feb is £175. Deposits for applications after this date will be £210. Payment must be via credit/ debit card or cheque.

Will I get my deposit back?

Yes. Providing you complete all the shifts you have been contracted for and fulfil the job satisfactorily you will have your deposit refunded on 24th July. CTM will refund all deposits by cheque to the original payee.

Cancellations

Cancellations prior to the 1st May 2009 will receive a 100% deposit refund via the deposit method used. After this time deposits will not be refunded other than in exceptional circumstances.

How do I apply?

- ✓ Download the application form, complete it and send it to CTM Office. Include two passport size photos (name on reverse) and mark the envelope GFLE09.
- ✓ If you wish to pay by cheque rather than card, send your cheque with your application form. Make cheques payable to *Cash and Traffic Management* and write name of applicant on reverse.
- ✓ Once we have received your application and photographs, we will contact you about deposit payment.

- ✓ Once payment has cleared we will discuss and arrange shifts with you. If payment is cancelled you will not be employed at the festival by CTM. It will only be possible to book a maximum of 2 places per card or cheque
- ✓ Once we have agreed shifts we will send you a confirmation letter. This letter will be proof of your shifts and must be taken to the festival and shown on site

When is the closing date for applications?

Applications must be received by 1st April. After this date places are unlikely to be available. Positions go quickly so to get your preferred shift and avoid disappointment apply promptly.

Can my friends work?

We will try to accommodate groups of friends wishing to work together on the same shift patterns. To increase the chances of this please apply at the same time, although people will not be able to book their friends in.

Please note however, even if you are on the same shift pattern as friends it is unlikely that you will be working near each other onsite as we require staff over a vast area.

Where will I stay?

CTM has its own secure campsite just outside the fenceline with its own toilets and showers. All employees must camp within CTM compound

When do I need to get there?

If starting work between the Sunday and Tuesday you will need to arrive at least 2 hours before your first shift. If you arrive late your job cannot be guaranteed.

If starting on the Wednesday you will need to arrive by 5pm on the Tuesday night. You will be required to go to a staff briefing and orientation session (details on paperwork)

My Friends are going to Glastonbury this year can I camp with them?

Only if they are working for CTM too. Otherwise they will not be allowed to camp in the secure compound and you will not be able to camp in public areas

What do I need to bring with me?

You will need to bring a tent and any camping equipment that you may need whilst you are site. Suncream, hats and drinking water is always a good idea. Although food is widely available on site you may want to get some shopping before you arrive! Be aware that shops are some distance from site and onsite provisions can be expensive! Make sure you bring paperwork you have been sent by the CTM office

Food & Drink

When working between the Wednesday and Monday you will be provided with a basic packed lunch. Please let us know in advance if you have any special dietary requirements. We recommend you bring additional food and water for your shifts.

What about clothing?

Whilst working you will be required to wear black trousers, sturdy black shoes, white shirt and high viz jacket (high viz will be provided at the briefing)

You will need to ensure that you have suitable clothing for all climates and conditions. Over a 12 hour shift the temperature can change rapidly. Make sure you have adequate jumpers/ t- shirts etc (wellies and waterproofs are always recommended). Make sure you bring sturdy footwear- you will not be allowed to work with vehicles in flip-flops or sandals!

When will I get my ticket?

You will get your ticket once you have completed 3 of your shifts.
